As long as traumatic injury remains the #1 cause of death and disability among children, teens and young adults, the ThinkFirst National Injury Prevention Foundation will work diligently on their behalf. The past year has been an exciting, productive year, as we continue to provide outstanding injury prevention programs to as many schools and communities as possible.

This past June, the ThinkFirst Foundation took advantage of the current market by relocating to an office in Naperville, Illinois. The city's mayor, chamber of commerce, businesses and friends welcomed us with a festive ribbon cutting, which was televised locally. We can now comfortably accommodate visitors and volunteers who assist with fundraising, office work and IT needs.

Businesses and organizations are recognizing our ability to add purpose to their own annual events. JLowe Racing, Siemens Gigaset, Enviro Packaging Solutions and a local church clothing sale all directed portions of their fundraising proceeds to the ThinkFirst Foundation, to help reduce childhood injuries. This type of partnership is especially helpful to nonprofit organizations such as ours, allowing us to devote our time and resources to program development.

Medical companies supported our Chapter Training Fund that will help facilitate the training we require and provide to chapters. This will assure chapter success and program consistency.

The number of individual donors increased, as most people either know someone who has been seriously or fatally injured, and want to prevent their family from being affected in this way. The value of prevention in healthcare savings has also been an influence. For some, contributing meant joining the ThinkFirst marathon team. Runners from Illinois, Wisconsin and our ThinkFirst Navajo chapter in New Mexico joined us at this year's Chicago Marathon. Thank you to all who supported their efforts. And last, but hardly least, I want to acknowledge the nurses, therapists, health educators, VIP peereducators and physicians supported by hospitals, medical universities and medical practices. You are the foundation of our 130 national and 36 international chapters, providing powerful, yet sensitive presentations that resonate with teens and children in schools everywhere. You are helping us shift the culture toward one of safer attitudes and actions — helping the norms shift in many ways, such as buckling up, putting phones away while driving, playing sports responsibly and avoiding violence. We owe you a debt of gratitude and applaud your commitment to community education.

ThinkFirst chapters provide more than 7,000 presentations a year in the U.S. alone. They rely on the ThinkFirst Foundation for training and educational materials, such as the Think About Your Choices DVD that was subtitled in Spanish, French and English this year.
