- Men on both sides of Michael's family served in the military. His maternal grandfather, Arthur Shorthair, was in the Army during World War II, and his father and paternal grandfather both served in the Air Force.
- Michael was attracted to the Marine Corps because it offered a chance to test his own limits. Michael served as a corporal in the 1st Battalion, 4th Marines from 2004 to 2008 and was deployed twice to the Iraq-Syrian border.
- The Michael G. Yazzie-King Scholarship, administered by Eve's Fund for Native American Health Initiatives, is available to Navajo youth who, like Michael, desire to pursue vocational training.
